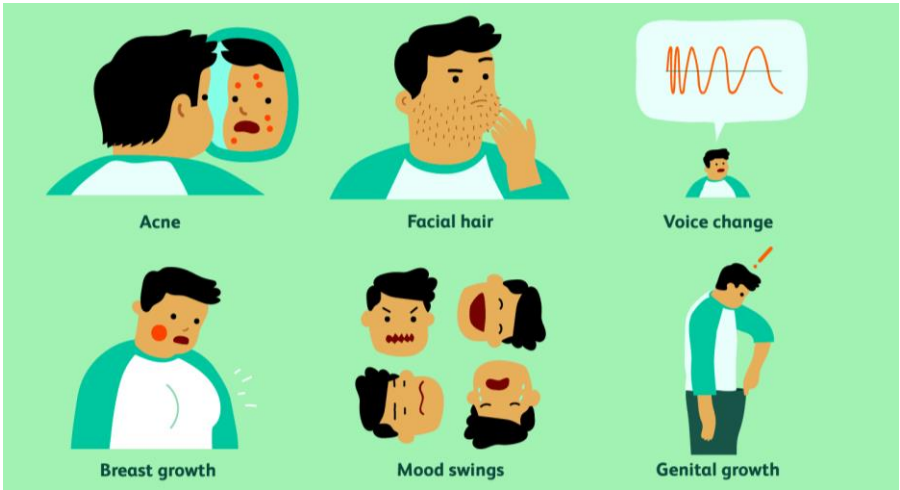
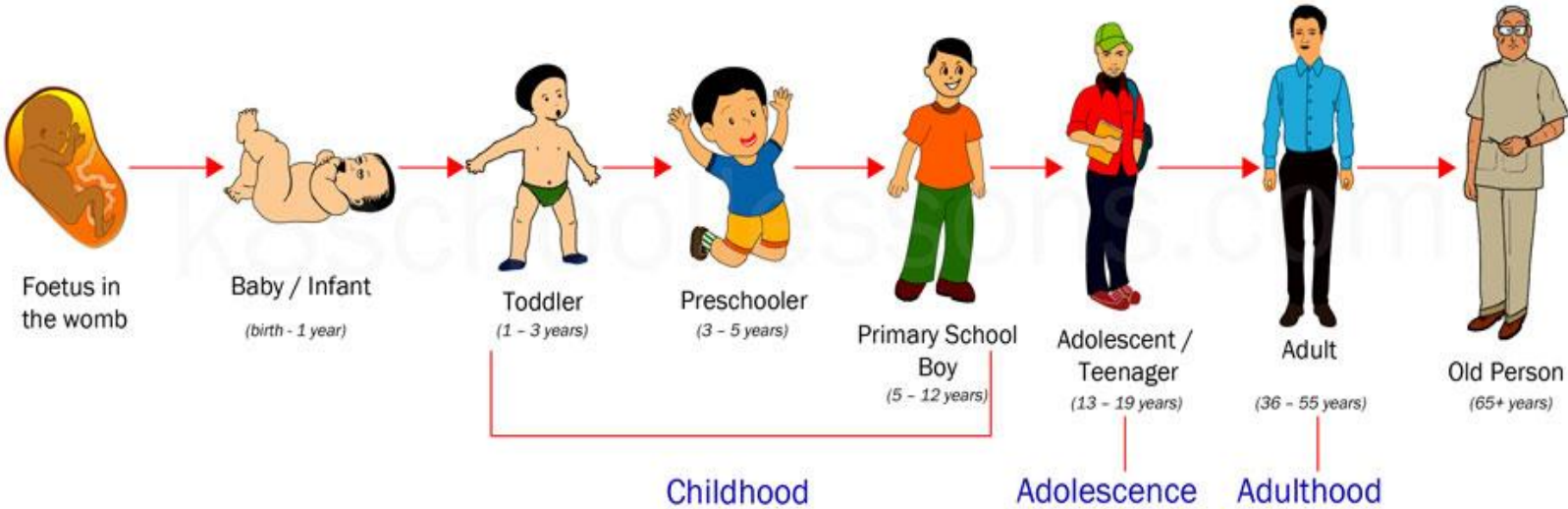
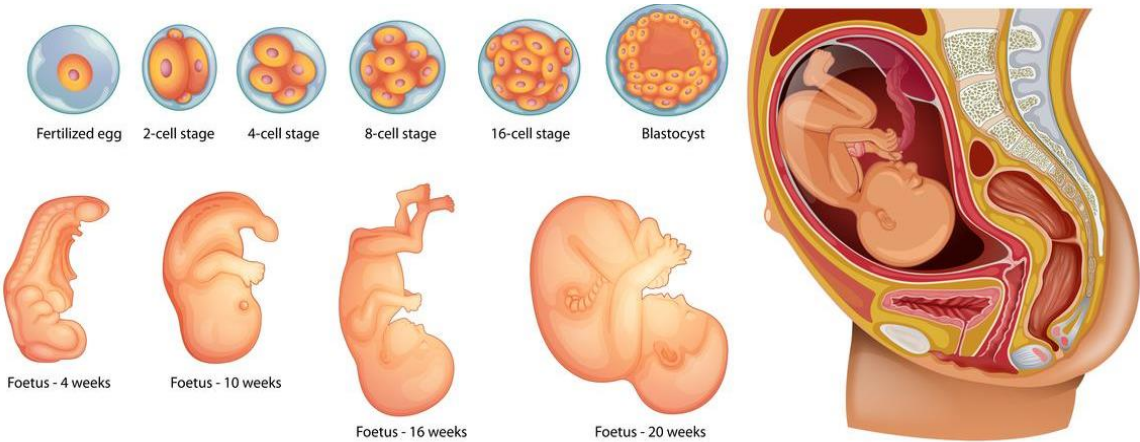

Vocabulary	Definition
adolescence	the phase of life where a child develops into an adult
breasts	the enlarged parts of woman's chest that produce milk after having a baby
egg	produced in a woman's ovaries
lifecycle	the stages a living thing goes through in its life
penis	an organ that male mammals use to release urine and sperm
period	lasting for two to seven days, blood and tissue leave a woman's body through the vagina
puberty	the process of change from a child to an adult
sperm	the fluid produced by a man
testicles	the part of the male body where sperm is produced and stored
vagina	an opening in female mammals that leads to the uterus
