We expect our children in Year 6 to...

- read their school library book for fifteen minutes at least three times per week
- complete their spelling activity sheet to reinforce spelling rules once per fortnight
- practise their times tables as required

The following tasks are optional but we encourage that they are completed to further support your child's love of learning outside of the classroom. They can bring in completed work to share with the staff in class.

Reading 'How to Train Your Dragon' is a great story that links to our topic. Give it a read and design a comic based on the story. Make sure you use different comic book features!	Writing Our work this term focuses on fairy tales, rewriting them to be enjoyed by older children. Pick your favourite fairy tale and rewrite it as a short story, giving it a dark twist!	Mathematics Our current focus is number and place value. Spend some time researching rounding numbers, finding good methods to use. Design a poster to help you to remember the methods.
Science Our focus this half term is classification. Go on a nature walk with a parent or carer and take photos of different plants and animals that you see. Find out what they are called.	PE We're improving our throwing and catching skills in PE. Spend some time with a family member or friend improving your throwing skills with your weaker hand.	History Our topic is Invasion and we will be looking at the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings. Draw and label picture of an Anglo-Saxon warrior and a Viking warrior. Compare them.
Geography We'll be spending some time looking at Europe, especially countries in Scandinavia. Choose one of these countries and research it to produce a travel guide.	Art & Design Drawing is our current focus. Look at some Youtube drawing tutorials for kids. Can you improve your accuracy and shading?	Design & Technology Research Anglo-Saxon recipes and, with a parent or carer, complete a recipe at home. Taste it and give an honest evaluation.
Music Our music topic is World Unite. Spend some time listening to music from around the world. Think about what you like about the music and what you don't like.	Religion & Worldviews In R&W, we're currently learning about our names and where they come from. Research your surname to see where it originated and how it originated.	Computing We're looking at networks in computing. Research your home network – how does the internet get into your house and what devices is it used on? Make a diagram.
Spanish We're learning words for school and school items in Spanish. Can you find the names of 10 pieces of stationery in Spanish? Make a poster with their English and Spanish names.	PSHE Our focus in PSHE is family and relationships. We'll be looking at respect. Design a poster with the word respect in the middle and decorate it with what respect means to you.	Autumn 1 Year 6
