We expect our children in Year 6 to...

- read their school library book for fifteen minutes at least three times per week
- learn their spellings that are sent home, ready for a test
- practise their times tables as required

The following tasks are optional but we encourage that they are completed to further support your child's love of learning outside of the classroom. They can bring in completed work to share with the staff in class.

Reading At the start of this term, we will be reading 'I Know What You Did Last Wednesday' by Anthony Horowitz. Design an advertisement for Tim Diamond's Detective Agency.	Writing We're writing a postcard from a fairytale criminal! Make a wanted poster for Goldilocks, thinking about the crimes that she commits in Goldilocks and the 3 Bears.	Mathematics We're going to be focusing on ratio this half term. Design a poster explaining how to find and use ratio.
Science Our focus this half term is 'Light and Sight', which concentrates on how light. Make a shadow puppet and explain how shadows are made.	PE In PE, we will focus on teamwork. Come up with 5 rules for successful team work.	History Our topic is 'Crime & Punishment'. We will look at how crime and punishment has changed overtime. Choose a period of time and create a fact file based on the most common crimes and subsequent consequences during this time.
Geography We looked at counties last half term. Design a brochure for a county of your choice. You'll need to do some research to learn about the culture of the county.	Art & Design This term we are looking at water colour in Art & Design. Choose a colour and find contrasting and complementing colours for it.	Design & Technology This term we are looking at 'Mechanical Systems'. Design & create a mechanical system that will transport a sweet treat from the cupboard to your seat of choice.
Music Our music topic is 'Growth'. This will focus on street performances, busking and flash mobs. Rehearse and perform your own flash mob to family and friends.	Religion & Worldviews We are focusing on 'Justice and Freedom'. Create a list of activities that provide you with a sense of freedom. You can reflect on this when you need some time to relax!	Computing This term we are working on Coding. Complete some of the coding activities on Purple Mash. Remember – it has guidance tips to help you!
Spanish We're going to be learning about weekend activities in Spanish. Write a list of things you do on a weekend and then translate them into Spanish using an online translator.
