We expect our children in Year 6 to...

- read their school library book for fifteen minutes at least three times per week
- learn their spellings that are sent home, ready for a test
- practise their times tables as required

The following tasks are optional but we encourage that they are completed to further support your child's love of learning outside of the classroom. They can bring in completed work to share with the staff in class.

Reading We're reading the book Holes by Louis Sachar. Research Louis Sachar as an author and produce a fact file about his life and the books he has written.	Writing Our current learning is a story set in a busy city. Research the capital city of a country of your choice. Produce a list of words that describe what it would be like to be there.	Mathematics Design a poster about place value, including decimals up to thousandths. Include information about rounding and calculation with decimals.
Science We're still focusing on Light and Sight this half term. Draw a diagram of the human eye. Include information about the eye works.	PE We will be studying dance this half term in PE. Find some famous dances from musicals, films or TV shows. Write a list of your favourites and explain why.	History We did a lot of learning about Crime and Punishment last term. Read a children's book that has a crime as one of the main plot points. Analyse it – are the crime, investigation methods and punishment factually accurate?
Geography Our focus this term moves to globalisation. Research where all the parts of a smartphone come from.	Art & Design We looked at water colour last half term. Produce an outline of something at home, ready to paint.	Design & Technology We're going to be creating an interactive museum in DT, using our history work on punishments. Choose a punishment and design a museum display about it.
Music Our music topic is 'Roots'. Choose your favourite musical artist and find out about their background. Produce a leaflet about their early life.	Religion & Worldviews In RW, our focus will shift to Easter. Draw a storyboard that recaps the key points of the Easter Story.	Computing Continue to complete some of the Coding activities on Purple Mash.
Spanish We'll be moving on to animal habitats this half term. Choose an animal, find out about them and where they live and use an online translator to translate into Spanish.
