Reading

Writing

We are encouraging the children to have a go at mark making to develop their pre writing skills. Draw a picture of a superhero, alien or a monster.

Mathematics

We are looking at numbers from 1 to 5 this half term.
Can you count to 5?
Can you count a set of 5 objects?
Have a go at writing numbers 1 to 5.

Phonics

Can you recognise any words that start with the same sound as your name?

Singing

Learn the song '5 Little Men in a Flying Saucer'.
Learn the song 'Tommy Thumb'.
Can you remember the names of all the fingers?

Fine Motor Skills

Fine motor skills are so important for everything your child does. Have a go at fastening buttons on an item of clothing or doing up a zip.

Gross Motor Skills

Do you know how to do a star jump?
Ask a grown up to show you! Then have a competition of how many star jumps you can do in 20 seconds.

Expressive Arts & Design

Dress up like a superhero. Which superhero are you?
You could make your superhero a mask or a superhero gadget!

PSED

We will be learning how to take turns and sharing in school. Can you play a game where you have to take turns? Or throw and catch with a grown up taking turns.

Communication and Language

Go on a walk and see what different types of buildings you see. Can you name them all?
Draw a picture or take some photos of what you see.

Understanding the World

Look at some photos of a holiday or special place you have been to.
What is different about the place? What looks the same?
What did you do there?

Understanding the World

We will be taking about forces – push and pull and floating and sinking.
What things do you push? What things can you pull?
Investigate what things float when you have a bath!

Mathematics

Can you describe your route to school?
Do you cross a road? Do you go over a bridge? Do you go around a corner?
Use positional language to describe your route to school.

Physical Development

How fast can you run?
Have a running race with a grown up or your friends.
Who is the fastest?
