Our topic this half term is: I wonder moves

We expect our children in F1 to...

- Share a book or favourite story with a grown up

The following tasks are optional but we encourage that they are completed to further support your child's love of learning outside of the classroom. They can bring in completed work to share with the staff in class or you can send up a picture on Class Dojo.

Reading

We will be reading the story '10 Little Monkeys'. If you have this story you can share it together. If you don't, you can find a link to the story on YouTube.

Writing

We are encouraging the children to have a go at mark making to develop their pre writing skills. Draw a picture of something that moves – a vehicle or an animal. If your child is ready let them have a go at writing their name.

Mathematics

We are looking at numbers from 5 to 10 this half term. Can you count to 10? Can you count a set of 10 objects? Have a go at writing some numbers.

Phonics

10 Little Monkeys is a rhyming story. Can you pick out the rhyming words you hear in the story?

Singing

Learn the song 'The Wheels on the Bus'.
Learn the song 'The Grand Old Duke of York'. Can you march along to the rhythm of the song?

Fine Motor Skills

Fine motor skills are so important for everything your child does. Have a go at threading some pasta onto a string or some cheerios onto a stick of dry spaghetti.

Gross Motor Skills

Have a go at moving in different ways. Jump, hop, skip, run, walk, shuffle, wiggle, spin, crawl, climb. What is your favourite way of moving?

Expressive Arts & Design

Why not try and make a musical instrument. Use some objects that you have at home. Can you make a drum? Use it to play along with the songs you have been learning.

PSED

We are going to be looking at road safety. Encourage your child to cross the road safely. Remember 'stop, look and listen' when you cross the road.

Communication and Language

Go on a walk and see what different types of transport you see. Can you name them all? Draw a picture or take some photos of what you see.

Understanding the World

Go on a walk to the docks or the train station. Talk about the different types of transport you see and where it might be going. Have you ever been on a train or a boat?

Understanding the World

We are looking at forces! Investigate what floats and what sinks. Can you make a collection of things that float and things that sink?

Mathematics

We are looking at shapes in the environment. What shapes can you see? Have a look at some road signs, what shapes are they?

Physical Development

Keep practicing putting your coats on. Can you ride a bike or a scooter? Have fun practicing riding on something that has wheels!

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
