Our topic this half term is: I wonder about the world

We expect our children in F1 to...

- Share a book with a grown up

The following tasks are optional but we encourage that they are completed to further support your child's love of learning outside of the classroom. They can bring in completed work to share with the staff in class or you can send up a picture on Class Dojo.

Reading We will be reading the story 'We're going on a bear hunt'. If you have this story you can share it together. If you don't, you can find a link to the story on YouTube.	Writing We are encouraging the children to have a go at mark making. Draw a picture of your house or a building that you have seen.	Mathematics We are looking at numbers from 6 to 10 this half term. Can you count to 10? Can you count a set of 10 objects?
Phonics Make up some patterns of clapping and tapping your feet. Can you clap twice and tap your feet twice in a pattern?	Singing Practice singing the songs '5 fat sausages sizzling in a pan' and '1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive'. Or you can sing some Christmas songs!	Fine Motor Skills Fine motor skills are so important for everything your child does. Have a go at finger painting. Just use your finger tips to create some pictures. Or use a cotton bud instead of your finger tip!
Gross Motor Skills Practice throwing and catching with a grown up. You can do this with a large ball or a small ball or even just a small soft toy. How many times can you throw and catch before you drop it?	Expressive Arts & Design Have a go at making some of your own Christmas cards or Christmas decorations. Practice cutting out some shapes – be careful when using scissors.	PSED We are encouraging the children to be more independent when getting dressed. Practice putting on a pair of gloves and your hats!
Communication and Language Have a go at making your own instrument – a shaker is really easy to make. Use it to play along to some of your favourite songs.	Understanding the World Go for a walk to the docks or the train station and watch what is happening. What did you see? What was happening? Draw a picture of what you saw.	Understanding the World Can you find something that is soft, hard, shiny, bumpy, rough, light, heavy, fluffy, squishy? Take a picture of what you have found.
Mathematics We are learning about things that match – like a pair of socks. Help a grown up pair up some socks or find some matching shoes.	Physical Development Keep practicing putting your coats on. How many jumps can you do in 10 seconds? Challenge a grown up to a jumping competition!	Autumn 2 F1
